General Plan is required by State law




Last comprehensive update was in 1994

 The Draft General Plan incorporates all of the Policy Sets that the GPAC developed, reviewed, and commented on.




Includes the City Council Preferred Land Use Map.



 Developed to meet all applicable requirements of State Planning law.






Land Use Map Development














Big-Picture Land Use Goals









- Protect existing residential neighborhoods
- Spur job-growth and economic development by making the City more competitive in attracting large scale employers, tech, etc.
- Revitalize existing neighborhood commercial centers by allowing for limited housing and expanded retail/office potential
- Complement and support recent and ongoing planning and development efforts (Metro SP, Gateway-Main St. SP)
- Reduce existing and future land use conflicts by transitioning select areas from industrial/manufacturing to mixed use/residential
- Optimize land uses near transit
- Protect and strengthen the viability of the City's industrial lands
